

## **U13 Tournament Skills Competition**

The Skills Competition will be a fun way for your team to showcase their skills. From 12:00pm to 1:30pm on Saturday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023, teams will participate in 3 skills programs.

1. Fastest Skater:

A and B divisions will be separated, A will go first, B will go second.

- a. A teams can select 2 skaters per team
- b. B teams can select 1 skater per team
  - i. Any skater who skates on the inside of the pylons will be disqualified
- 2. Shoot-Out:

A and B divisions will be separated, A will go first, B will go second.

- a. All goalies and 1 shooter per team will participate
- b. All shooters will shoot once on each goalie, the goalies will change, and all shooters will shoot again, until all goalies have participated
- c. The goalie with the highest save percentage wins
- d. The shooter with the most goals wins
  - i. In the event that shooters tie, the tied shooters will complete a best of three sudden-death shoot out on the winning goalie;
  - ii. In the event that goalies tie, the tied goalies will complete a best of three sudden-death shoot out by the winning shooter;
  - iii. In the event that there are tied shooters and tied goalies, the shooters will shoot three times on each goalie.
- 3. Agility Relay
  - A and B divisions will be separated, A will go first, B will go second.
    - a. Each team will choose 4 players to participate in an agility relay race;
    - b. Teams will line up on one end of the arena. The first skater will stick handle a puck weaving in and out of pylons to the end of the rink. They will then race back to their team passing the puck to their second skater, until all skaters have completed the relay;
    - c. The team to complete the relay the fastest, wins.
      - i. Any skater who does not weave in and out of the pylons disqualifies their team
      - ii. Any skater who begins skating before the puck has been passed to them at the red line, disqualifies their team
